- Decide how you will travel to the Phoenix Park well in advance. You are strongly advised to take public or group transport to this event.
- Public transport and coaches will be given priority and will bring you closest to Phoenix Park.
- It will not be possible to drive up to or near to the Phoenix Park by car.

An enhanced Sunday schedule will operate on all commuter routes into and out of Dublin city on Sunday 26 August. Those wishing to travel to Dublin via this service should refer to the website [www.buseireann.ie](http://www.buseireann.ie) for the most up to date timetable information. **If you have a ticket for the Phoenix Park Mass, you will be allowed to travel for free within Dublin on this service.**

Regardless of your transport option choice, this day will include considerable walking. Therefore appropriate footwear and weather related clothing is advisable.
